The Pakistan Bar Council has added a new Rule 108-C (6) to the Pakistan Legal Practitioners and Bar Councils Rules, 1976, outlining the uniform and conduct for law students and apprentices:

Uniform for Male students:

White shirt, gray coat, maroon tie.

Female students: Gray coat with maroon dupatta/shawl/scarf

Male apprentices: White shirt, black coat, maroon tie.

Female apprentices: Black coat with maroon dupatta/shawl/scarf.

Law students attending court for research must adhere to the prescribed dress code.

Students and apprentices are prohibited from campaigning or participating in Bar Council and Bar Association elections.

In case of Non-Compliance:

Complaints to the Bar Council: If proven, the apprenticeship period may be extended to 12 months.

Complaints to the institution: If proven, the apprenticeship period may be extended to 18 months.
